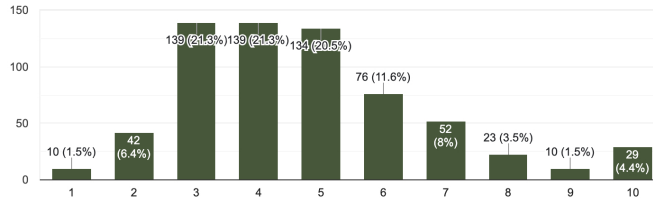

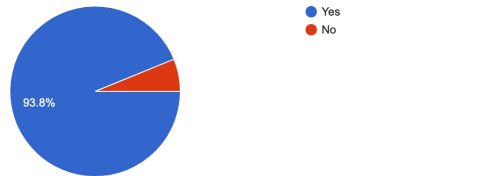

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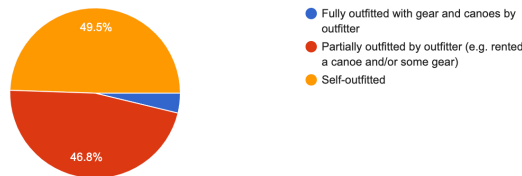

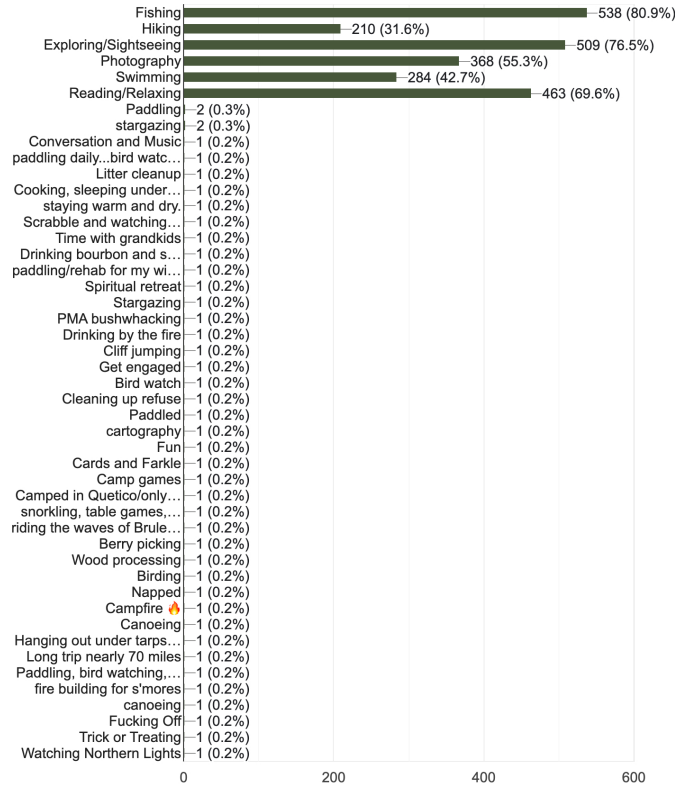

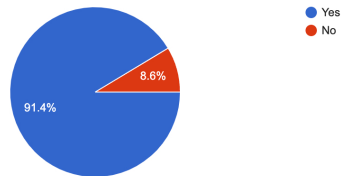

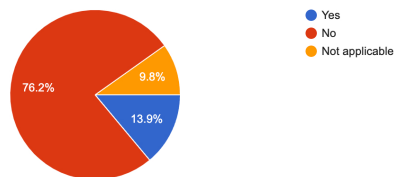

Sometimes use them, sometimes don't. Didn't use one on this trip but am not against them.

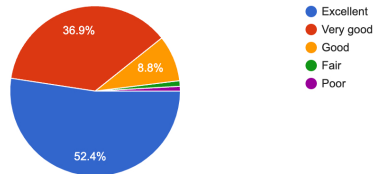
Tow for the first 5 miles to save time as were pushing in 15-20 miles.

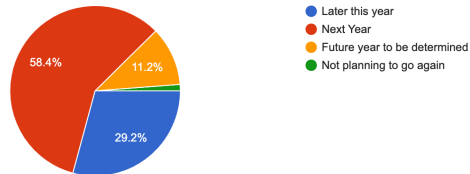
